ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Texas, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is Sierra Crest Home-Owners Association, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- 1. To provide a means of administering, preserving, maintaining, enforcing and assuring the continued retention of open space in Sierra Crest, a real estate subdivision, subject to Section 25-21.2 of the El Paso City Code or any amendment thereto, or any addition or additions as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this corporation, in accordance with the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Retrictions for Sierra Crest, filed or to be filed in the Office of the County Clerk of El Paso County, Texas.
- 2. To contract and pay for private security, maintenance of all streets, supplies and services of whatever nature in maintaining the open areas and to employ all other personnel reasonably necessary for the accomplishments and the operation of the various purposes outlined herein.

- 3. To fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration and to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association.
- 4. To purchase, merge, consolidate or otherwise join with other non-profit corporations organized for the same or similar purposes or annex additional residential property and common area.
- 5. To enter into general and limited partnerships with other corporations, associations and individuals for the accomplishment of the various purposes outlined herein.
- 6. To have and to exercise all of the powers conferred upon non-profit corporations by the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act.

ARTICLE FIVE
